

SHAWBURY PARISH COUNCIL – AWARDS

1. COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARDS – SPONSORED BY RAF SHAWBURY

Each year the Parish Council will present Community Service Awards to residents or workers in the Parish, who have been nominated for giving outstanding service to the Community.

There are two levels of award – (a) for adults and (b) for those under eighteen years of age. There is no restriction on the number that can be awarded each year.

Elected Councillors can be nominated for community activity which is not related to their responsibilities as a Councillor.

Nominations for the award may be made by local parishioners and forwarded to the Parish Clerk before March 31st. with brief supporting information about the reasons the person is being nominated.

Members will consider the applications at the Parish Council meeting held on the second Tuesday in April and those who are successful will be informed by the Clerk of their award and invited to attend the Annual Parish Meeting, when the awards will be presented.

Those receiving an award will receive a plaque and a printed certificate and these will be presented by a representative from RAF Shawbury.

2. PARISH COUNCIL GROUP AWARD

The Parish Council will make this award annually, if merited, to any club; group; society or organization that has achieved outstanding success, bringing credit to it and the Parish.

Nominations for the award, with detailed reasons, may be made by any serving Councillor at the February meeting of the Council. The nomination will need a seconder and be approved by a majority of those attending the meeting.

Representatives of organizations gaining the award will be invited to attend the Annual Parish Meeting, where they will be presented with an appropriate plaque by the Council Chairman.
