## Fitness Area:

When the Parish Plan was compiled a few years ago, one of the developments requested was to have a fitness circuit as part of the footpaths being constructed in the Moat and Glebe areas.

Since then there has been a move away from this type of development towards creating fitness areas which are accessible to anyone over the age of 12 years.

A local plan has been suggested at a number of meetings and has met with general approval and the Council is keen to construct one on the playing field. Members have identified an area of land between the footpath leading to the school and the boundary for Church Street virtually opposite the Library. An application for permission to do this has been made to the Diocese, who own the land and efforts are underway to secure a grant from the lottery fund, without which it will not be possible to fund it. Members would welcome the views of parishioners on this proposal, which will be considered in detail at the next Council meeting on October 13<sup>th</sup>.

At the Council meeting held in September, Members were surprised and delighted to receive a donation of £300. 00 from RAF Shawbury, which was part of the money raised at the recent motor cycle event held on the airfield.
