GRANTS & DONATIONS POLICY

1. Purpose of the Policy

Shawbury Parish Council awards grants to support organisations and activities that benefit residents of Shawbury Parish. Grant funding is provided from an annual budget agreed by the Council as part of its precept.

2. Types of Grants

Minor Grants: Typically up to £200 per organisation per financial year.

Major Grants: Normally up to £500 per project for clearly defined development projects.

3. Eligibility

4. Application Process

Applications must be made using the Council's application form and include recent financial accounts. Major grant applications must include project details and quotations.

5. Decision-Making

Councillors will assess eligibility, benefit to residents, realism of costs, and availability of alternative funding.

6. Payment and Monitoring

Approved grants will be paid by bank transfer, usually before the end of March. Recipients may be required to report on how funds are spent.

7. Unsuccessful Applications

Applicants will be informed by the Parish Clerk and may receive guidance for future applications.
